It is a resident-friendly city with several parks, forested areas and sport facilities, which are conducive to active relaxation and allow practicing different kinds of sport.


Cultural institutions such as theatrs, cinemas, and interesting museums turn Katowice into a city which is never boring.

OUR DISTRICT - KOSTUCHNA

A district of Katowice in the southern complex of districts. It borders with the Piotrowice-Ochojec, Zarzecze, Podles, Murcki districts and the city of Tychy. It has a suburban, residential and industrial character (KWK Murcki). It has an area of 8.59 km² and a population of 11.000



HISTORY OF OUR SCHOOL

- ◉ In 1945 the Follow-up Coal Industry Professional School was created.
- ◉ In January 1986, on the 40th anniversary of the school, it was given the name of „Tomasz Klenczar” as a patron.
- ◉ In 1958-1997 the school changed its name several times due to adjusting specializations to demands of the labour market.
- ◉ We introduced profiles: in 1990 the economic specialization, 2009 spedition profile, 2017 technician of airport operational services, 2019 refrigeration and air conditioning technician;
- ◉ We also offer an education for children in integrative classes and with disabilities in special classes.
- ◉ Since 2016 the school has been named Technical Engineering School no. 15 Tomasza Klenczara.
- ◉ in 2016, we celebrated the 70th anniversary of the school during a music picnic and concerts together with residents, invited guests and graduates





PATRON OF OUR SCHOOL – ING. TOMASZ KLENCZAR

Tomasz Klenczar was born on 11th of June 1886 in the village closeto Pszczyna.

He completed training at the „Emanuelssegen" mine, later he studied at the Institute of Geodesy of the Mining Academy in Berlin.

He created some of the first Polish mining institutions.

Klenczar was an excellent specialist in mining damages, participant of the Polish government's national referendum preparations, delegate to Paris in 1921.

He was arrested by the Nazis in 1940 and spent several months in the Dachau and Mauthausen-Gusen concentration camps.

He died on 16th of April 1966 in Katowice. He also wrote poetry, played violin, spoke nine foreign languages.

SPEDITION

Organizes rail, road or air transport of exported and imported goods and goods transported within the country. It also prepares shipping instructions and information materials for customers and organizes the unloading of goods or their loading into cars, wagons, planes.

Jobs: freight forwarders are primarily sought by companies in the industrial, construction, retail and service sectors, as well as IT and telecommunications.

There are many companies on the market that specialize in domestic and international freight forwarding. A specialist in this profession is also necessary in every company dealing with export or import of goods.



ECONOMY

- **The main aim of training in the profession of an economic technician is to prepare graduates to carry out the following tasks and studies: calculating indicators describing the financial situation of a company; we prepare graduates to work in insurance companies in the field of property and personal insurance.**
- **School cooperates with companies: Allianz, HDI providing students with a place to practice and opportunities to test their knowledge in practice.**



TECHNICIAN OF AIRPORT OPERATIONAL SERVICES

Performs tasks related to planning, organizing, coordinating and supervising the work of airport operational services, as well as cooperating with air navigation services and taking actions related to security and safe functioning of airports. An Airport Operations Technician should be proficient in two professional foreign languages, English being mandatory.



REFRIGERATION AND AIR CONDITIONING

The refrigeration and air conditioning technician organizes and executes works related to installation, start-up and service of refrigeration, air conditioning and heat pump systems and equipment as well as repairs and troubleshooting.

Graduates install refrigeration and air conditioning equipment and fill systems with refrigerant. Assesses the quality and condition of refrigeration equipment.

Maintains and repairs ventilation, refrigeration and air conditioning equipment
