
A lot has happened these months!

Titled "Recommendations to create bridges between VET and higher education systems for entrepreneurship", IO2 analyzed the situation in partner countries regarding the possibility of developing and confirming entrepreneurial competences in each country in the context of the national qualifications framework (NQF). Partners focused on searching solutions for bridges between individual education systems and entrepreneurship competence training programs in high schools and colleges in their countries and the possibilities of confirming and certifying qualifications. This was done thanks to interviews with entrepreneurs in partner countries and giving recommendation for the validation process.
